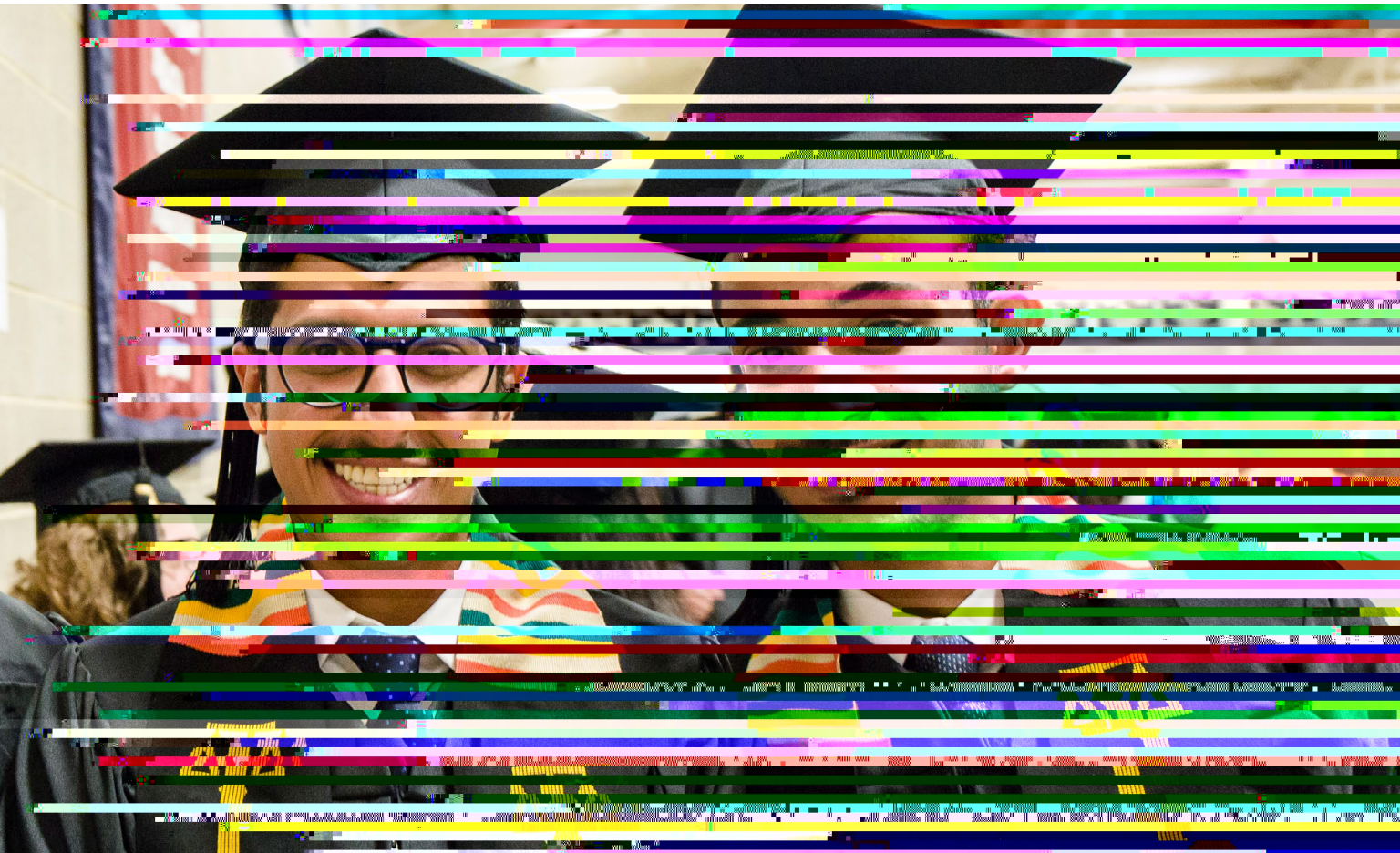
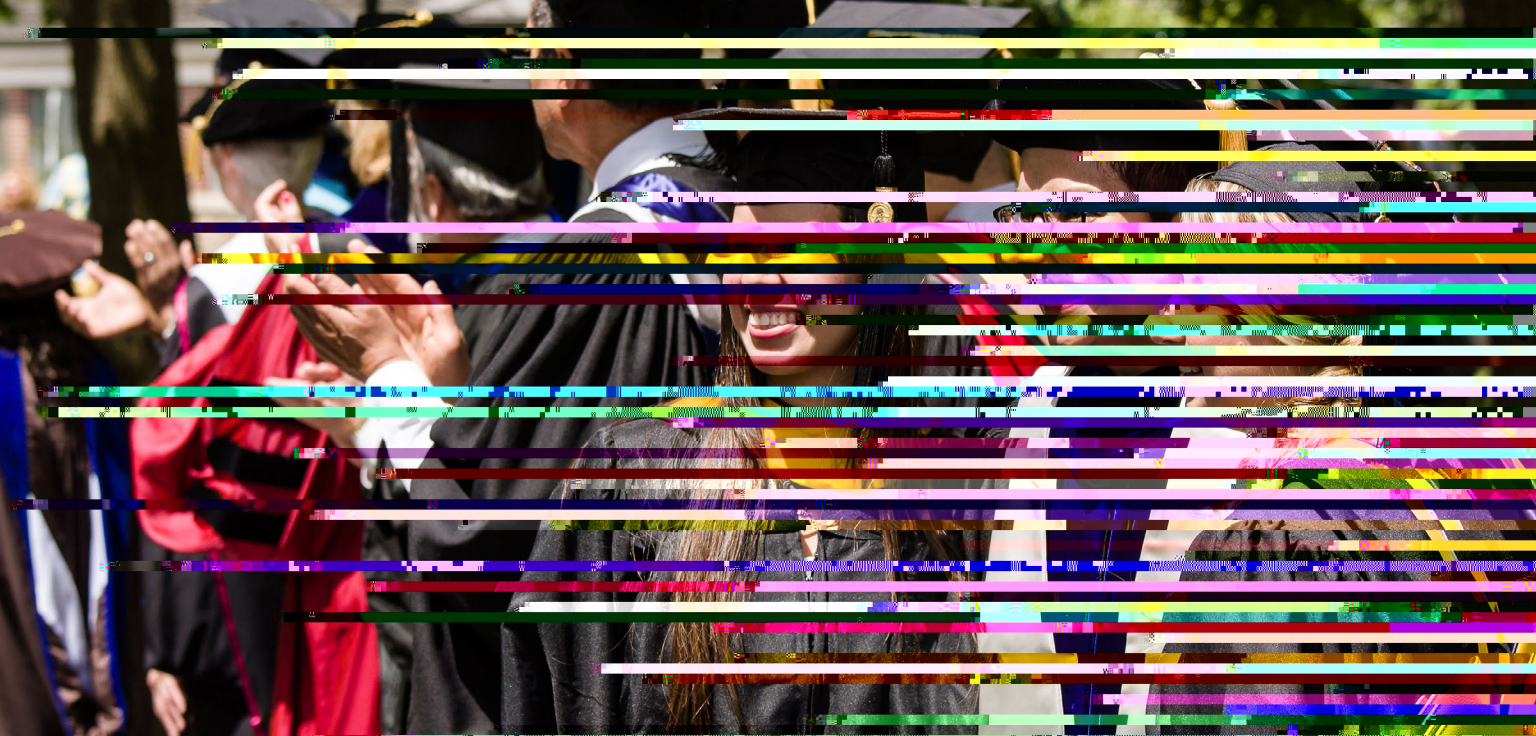

ANNUAL REPORT ON POST-GRADUATION ACTIVITY OF THE CLASS OF 2016

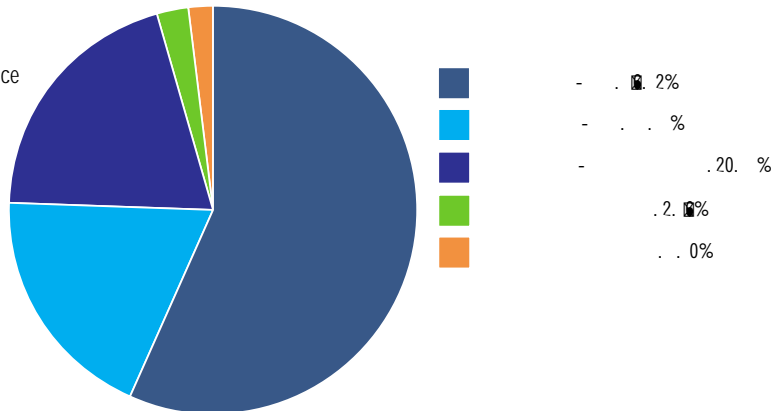




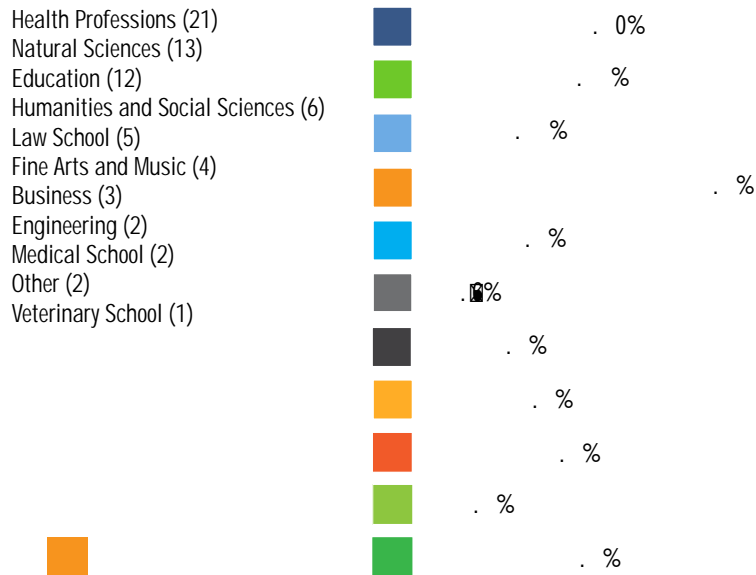
A total of 404 graduates from the Class of 2016, 87.13% of whom are based on a survey of 352 graduates.
